

April 9th, 16th, 23rd


We will focus on the fundamentals of sculpture and creating a variety of artworks using different techniques and materials in these three sessions.



Credit and Debit Cards are something children and young people can be confused about. It's important to teach children the difference between the two. Here are some key points about each type of card:

Debit Cards:

- Uses money already in your checking / spending account
- Cost of purchases is withdrawn from your account right away
- A minor can open a checking account and have a debit card with parental / guardian permission
- If fraud happens on the card, the card can be 'shut off', and the money refunded to the account

Credit Cards:

- The money used for purchases is borrowed and needs to be paid back
- If you do not pay the full balance monthly, interest will be charged to your account
- Interest is the cost of borrowing money
- You must be at least 18 and meet specific criteria to open a credit card.
- If fraud happens on the card, the card can be 'shut off', and the money refunded to the account.

With parental discretion, we encourage teens to have their own checking account with a debit card. This will help them learn financial responsibility by monitoring and keeping track of their spending.
